

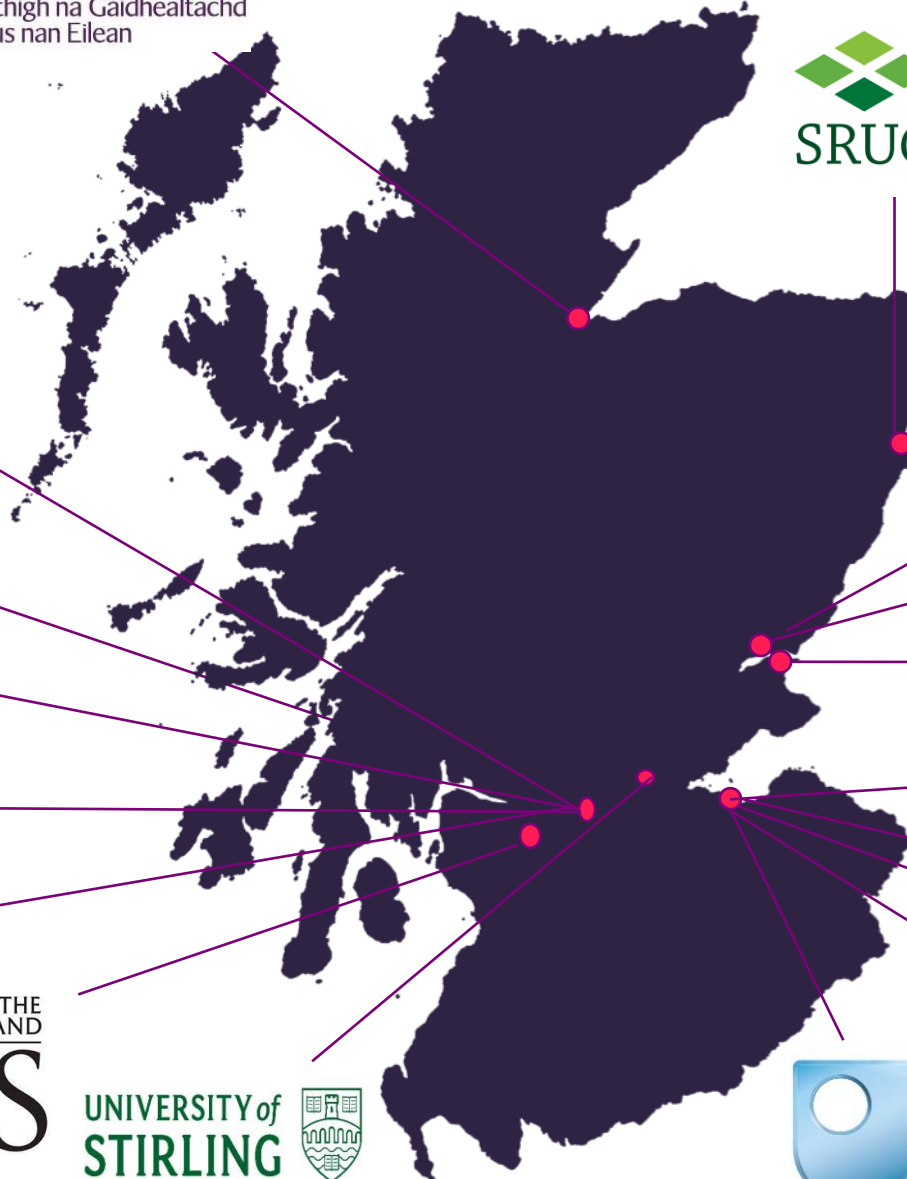

THE SCOTTISH DEGREE STRUCTURE

Bachelor's courses

Generally 4 years

- 3 years with advanced entry
- 5 years (Sandwich courses/Integrated Masters e.g. Engineering/Modern Languages)
- 5 – 6 years (Clinical courses, e.g. Medicine)
- Encourages independent thinking, reasoning and research skills
- Emphasis on independent study, self-motivation and critical thinking
- Study abroad options often available in 3rd year
- Academic year is divided into 2 semesters:
 - Semester 1 September – December
 - Semester 2 January – May



- 3 year degree
- Subject chosen from start
- **Focused**



- 4 year degree
- Subject chosen from start but can change up to end of 2nd year
- **Flexible**



- 4 year degree
- General education for first 2 years
- **Broad**

FEES AND FINANCE

- Tuition Fees vary by institution (starting around \$10,000 USD)
- Cost of living starting around \$15,000 per year – lower than in many other UK locations
- Federal aid, GI Bill, and provincial funding may be used – check with individual institutions
- Scholarships available – check with individual institutions
